Winter Uniform

- 1 **Either** a plain mid to dark grey **knee-length** skirt with pleats or a **knee-length** straight skirt with a **back** split of **no more** than 15cms **or** plain mid to dark grey TAILORED trousers (black or charcoal may NOT be worn; **stretch or tightly fitting trousers may NOT be worn**). Only plain, narrow, black or grey belts may be worn.
- 2 Long-sleeved white, plain school blouse (not fitted or fashion blouse and no motif).
- 3 A school tie in red with grey diagonal stripe, worn sensibly.
- 4 A long-sleeved plain V necked school pullover in pillar-box red, welted with school badge embroidered on the front.
- 5 Either **short** plain grey, black or white socks, or plain grey, black or skin coloured tights
- 6 Shoes should be **low wide heeled (not low stiletto style)** in black and of an appropriate style. **Please note: backless shoes, slingbacks or trainer shoes may NOT be worn.**
Low wide heeled (not low stiletto style) ankle boots in black and of an appropriate style may be worn with **trousers ONLY**.
- 7 Outdoor coats should be in styles and colours compatible with the school uniform.

Protective Clothing

For Science and Technology lessons, all girls require a red tabard with grey binding and a large pocket. The student's initials (about 1" high) should be embroidered on the left front with grey embroidery silk.

Please note: Long hair must be completely removed from the face and securely fastened for all Technology and Science practicals.

Optional Items of Wear

- 1 A school blazer in grey with an embroidered badge of the school crest on the top pocket of the blazer.
- 2 A white, short-sleeved, open-necked plain flat collared school blouse (not a fashion blouse, nor a polo shirt, and no motif) may be worn from 1st May.
- 3 Girls may choose not to wear short socks or tights from 1st May.

Games and PE Kit

- 1 A red polo shirt – the student's initials (about 1" high) should be embroidered on the left front with grey embroidery silk. The school badge should be embroidered on the front
- 2 Plain black football shorts. There will be no other motif. The student's initials (about 1" high) should be embroidered on the left front leg with red embroidery silk.
- 3 Plain black tracksuit bottoms, compulsory please (These are available from Rawcliffes). $\frac{3}{4}$ length and combat trousers are not substitutes for full length tracksuit bottoms.
- 4 A school cotton drill top in pillar-box red with the school badge, and the student's initials embroidered on the front.
or
A school sweat shirt in pillar-box red with the school badge, and the student's initials embroidered on the front.
- 5 Hockey /football socks with red leg and grey top and no motif – NAMED.
- 6 Plain white ankle socks with no motif – NAMED.
- 7 White trainers with non-marking soles (no boot trainers), or pumps/plimsoles. Trainers must be laced up correctly and efficiently at all times. They should have a sole which will absorb shock and be appropriate for games and PE activities – NAMED
- 8 Football boots and shin pads – NAMED.
- 9 Towel – NAMED.

Please note:

- 1 **All PE kit and inhalers/medication must be named with the student's FULL NAME.**
- 2 **Long hair must be completely removed from the face and securely fastened for all P.E./Sports activities.**
- 3 **A gumshield is highly recommended for hockey and rugby.**
- 4 **It is dangerous and forbidden to wear any form of body piercing during P.E. lessons. Therefore, it is strongly recommended that any piercing and healing takes place in the summer holidays.**
- 5 **It is the student's responsibility to bring an inhaler to every lesson and administer as required.**

Optional Games and PE Kit

- 1 Change of underwear.
- 2 Years 9, 10 and 11 ONLY – a white polo shirt (with no motif) instead of the red polo shirt.

Jewellery & Make Up

A wristwatch may be worn.

Girls may wear SMALL STUDS – a maximum of one per ear in the lobe of the ear. STUDS MUST BE REMOVED FOR ALL PE AND GAMES LESSONS and during such lessons, will remain the responsibility of the student. NO OTHER JEWELLERY MAY BE WORN.

Nail varnish may not be worn. Make up must not be worn by students in Year 7 & 8. In Year 9, 10 and 11 Mascara, lip balm, concealer and natural foundation may be applied but subtly.

Hair

Hairstyles must not be extreme and only natural hair colours are permissible. Students must seek advice from the Year Group Leader about the acceptability of any proposed change which might be considered extreme. Hair accessories must be deemed as practical.

Please note:

All garments, footwear and personal property must be clearly marked with the student's FULL NAME. This includes garments which will have the student's initials embroidered on the front. It is very difficult to return lost items of uniform to students from just the initials.

If uniform is obtained from other sources, school badges are available to purchase from Rawcliffes.
