



Leeds City Region








- Leeds City Region is a huge economy and considered global economic 'powerhouse'

- Over 126,000 businesses are located here











Calderdale




36% of people who live in Calderdale work outside the district and the average distance people travel or their job in Calderdale is 7.6miles!

- To work in the digital sector you need technical skills such as programming language e.g. Java, software and website development













- To work in the engineering and manufacturing sector you need technical and employability skills















Key projects in the engineering and manufacturing



 Over the next 5 years, £250million needs to be invested in Leeds City Region's medical technology sector, resulting in lots of scientific engineering and manufacturing jobs




 The City Region will be the UK leader in Light Rail and High Speed Rail with the introduction of High Speed Rail 2 (HS2)

- To work in the Construction and Infrastructure sector you need technical skills such as Computer Aided Design (CAD) and more generic skills such as contract management, project management and










Apprenticeships

Did you know...

- Apprenticeships enable you to work and learn at the same time
- Opportunities span across a range of subject areas. ICT, engineering, manufacturing and construction – all demand areas in our region
- The average wage for apprentices is £170 per week in the UK. Some apprenticeship programmes have starting salaries of £18-20k
- The wage following an engineering apprenticeship in our region is £20k -£25k








