

## **16 to 19 Tuition Fund Statement 2021-2022**

The tuition fund at North Halifax Grammar School will be used to support students aged 16-19 who fall into the following categories -

- Who have not achieved a grade 4 or 5 in English and/or Mathematics at GCSE
- Have a grade 4 or above in English and/or Mathematics, are from an economically disadvantaged background and would need catch-up support. These are defined as students from the 27% most economically deprived areas of the country based on the Index of Multiple Deprivation.

Tuition will be provided online either on a 1 to 1 basis or a 1 to 3 ratio. Students will have access to 1 hour a week of tuition which will be provided by a respected online provider. Tuition runs for 12 or 15 week blocks, starting in the Autumn or Spring term.

We have duly considered the quality of our tutoring provision, following the EEF evidence which suggests that small group tuition works better with the smallest groups and when the tuition is focused on students' specific needs. The impact and effectiveness of the tutoring will be reviewed regularly by the Director of Sixth Form.
