## North Halifax Grammar School: A-Level Results Summer 2018

Students at North Halifax Grammar School achieved another excellent set of A level results to maintain the three year value added score* which places the school in the top $25 \%$ of A level providers.
$25.4 \%$ of entries gained the highest grades of $A^{*}-A$ and $60.9 \%$ of all entries were of grades $A^{*}-B$ (in comparison to the national average of $52.7 \%$ ) and 56 of the 145 students gained grades $A^{*}-B$ in all subjects entered.

Over $85 \%$ of the exams taken resulted in a grade C or better, with the vast majority of grades achieved in demanding academic subjects. The overall pass rate ( $\left.A^{*}-E\right)$ was a fantastic $99.6 \%$.

These exam results enabled students to go on to further study in a wide range of demanding university courses, 6 students gaining entry into medicine/veterinary/dentistry. There was also an increased uptake of higher level apprenticeships with students demonstrating, not only their academic prowess, but also their excellent personal development through engagement in a wide variety of enrichment opportunities, demonstrating the school motto 'Living to Learn, Learning to Live'.
