Congratulations to our Year 13 students at. Fifty six percent of students achieved A\* to B grades in academic A Levels, with 17 students achieving all A\* and A grades.

Most will now take up their place at university including Oxford, Cambridge and Russell Group universities, while others will begin apprenticeships with prestigious firms such as Mazars, an international audit tax and advisory firm.
