

North Halifax Grammar School: A Level Results 2025

Our A Level results reflect the hard work of all students and staff with 72% of all grades this year being awarded at A*-B - and 27 students achieving all A* and A grades.

Results alone do not define our students who are courageous, kind, and independently-minded individuals, determined to go out into the world and make it a better place. Most take up places at universities across the country, including Oxford and Cambridge, with 56% of those attending Russell Group universities. Others will begin apprenticeships in a range of fields including nursing and business management. Students have chosen to explore a wide range of courses: Medicine, Marine Biology, Aerospace engineering, Biochemistry, Architecture and Law to name but a few.
