We would like to congratulate our students on the outcome of all their hard work as they celebrate their A Level successes.

Students attained an average grade B overall - a reflection of their hard work and commitment over their course of study, and of the dedication of their teachers. 86% of students received A Level passes at Grade C or above, with 20 students remarkably attaining all A*/A grades.
